



Junior School Visiting Parents Arrangements

When visiting the school please remember that there are many private areas of the school such as dormitories, changing rooms, staff accommodation and Senior School Boarding Houses. Parents are therefore requested not to visit dormitories, changing rooms, classrooms and the school's day to day activities while visiting the school. There may be times when parents may wish to visit the school such as when dropping something off which may have been forgotten. Visitors should always report to reception in these instances and we shall be very happy to help with your query. If reception is not open because it is late or at the weekend then parents should wait in the front hall area until duty staff arrive to attend to you.

Access to the School's Grounds

Access to the school is via two entrances: East and West Gates which are both controlled by electronic barriers. The East Gate is always in the closed position and the West Gate is always closed between the hours of 2130 and 0600. Access when the barrier is closed is via a security gate code and a code is always required for the East Gate. A security gate code can be requested by parents.
