School Uniform

Please also note the following:

- All students are required to have a pair of plain, flat-heeled, black polished leather shoe to be worn with Day and Going Out uniform and should also ensure they have an adequate supply of shoe cleaning equipment.
- All students should bring with them a set of clothes appropriate to wear at a ball, music concert or drama event, as well as a small selection of more casual items for less formal occasions. Please ensure that all items of clothing coming into school are named.
- Jewellery may be worn but items should be of simple appearance and kept to a minimum.
- Hair should be of a natural colour.

School Bag

A bag suitable for daily use and large enough to hold books and folders is essential. Students should also bring with them the following items:

Eraser
Pencil Sharpener

Essential Items

Essential items such as toiletries and snacks can be purchased twice a week from Duffus Post Office.

Linen

Boarders should bring with them a flame retardant, single duvet (one), pillow(s) and their own bed linen (two sets), which must be named. These items will be laundered by the school. For exchange students and those who are staying for two terms or less, however, the school can provide these items.



Expedition Equipment

Seamanship Equipment

All clothing and equipment required for sail training voyages is provided by the school. Personal wetsuits are optional but recommended for anyone intending to do sailing activities. All specialised clothing and personal safety equipment is provided.

Laundry and Dry Cleaning

The School runs its own laundry to which students can send washing, some items of which may be chargeable. Washing machines are also available in each Boarding House. Dry cleaning is sent to a local contractor.
